4. Administrator Update:

- a) Presentation from Jason Deis
 - Nike Fuel Band proposal. Integrate Technology into the Physical Education program. The goal is to get students to stay motivated, set daily goals with the band, easy to use, USB connection (no extra cables) and students can track their experience.
 - Teachers are participating and students can volunteer to participate in a competitive house challenge.
 - Require 10 bands which are \$150.00/band + tax. Requesting \$1575.00 to make a onetime purchase.
