Chair Update

- Welcome all old and new members. Looking forward to an exciting year.
- Thank you all leaving Council Members.
- Pancake breakfast final decision is to cancel this event as we do not have the funds remaining to ensure success. For context, traditionally at NMS there was a pancake breakfast to welcome students. This was later moved to end of year to welcome the grade 4s as a bid for community building.
- Council discussed a small alternative goodbye for the current students, but not the grade 4 cohort as they will be supported during a different even in June. Action item: Decide on the item to send off. Freezies is likely appreciated and will be the chosen send off item due to ease of storage and distribution. Date TBD.
- Update on Grade 8 graduation farewell: Photo booth has been booked by the students. Cost will be \$630.
- Relook at fundraising and ways to increase funds and work with SRC-discussed in further sections.
- Monthly School Council meetings first Mondays of the month. We will adjust for September as it is a long weekend Monday.

Teacher Update

• There will be an upcoming request for volunteers to support the grade 8 send-off.

• Grade 7 and 8 co-ed soccer team is playing tonight for the finals and secured Silver. Great job!

Fundraising Coordinator

- Amyna discussed fundraising every other month. Suggestions included and circulated are as follows:
 - Apples-September. Waiting for details on the initiative and we are currently on a waitlist. Council agreed we can proceed with this fundraiser.
 - Purdys Chocolates-November. We sell in time for the holidays.
 - Texas Donuts/Krispy Kreme-January. Revenue in the past was just over \$1000.
 - Treat bags-March.
 - May can be an open fundraising option. Examples include Epicurious, Spirit Way, flowers, honey sales (was reportedly not popular at the high school), family photo packages and other ideas welcomed. Amyna will circulate some information on Epicurious.
- Events are separate from fundraising, although they can bring in fundraising dollars. The goal of events should be focused on building partnerships with families as opposed to fundraising.

Hot Lunch Update

 <u>Heard</u> we are to encourage parents/community to connect directly with the campus first. If families approach us we are to direct them to campus staff and/or administration as per the policy so parents/families/communities can be best supported in their concerns.

Additional Items Discussed During the June 8th Meeting Added for Clarity:

- Discussed a bit more about what is happening on June 21st for the welcome to grade 4s. There is a combination of performances and interactive events.
- Admin talked about an upcoming ask for the next Terry Fox run to fund the purchase items appropriate for a lunch on the day for the students. As we integrate grade 4s into this event it could potentially be a co-joint funded lunch with the elementary councils (mindful that the elementary schools will be funding only for grade 4s and we will be covering 5s-8s). We are open to thinking about it, but we may have to confirm our

fundraising/future budget first. Faruq mentioned partnering with SRC for support on this initiative.

- Regarding SRC, they fundraise for goals. 1 for them and 1 for global. They set fundraising goals applicable to students. Admin is thinking of shrinking SRC in a way that allows them to focus on developing their skills and put more of the onus on campus council for fundraising. SRC is on board for this idea.
- For our next AGM it is recommended we stagger the student performances in a way to ensure families stay involved in the AGM instead of leaving.

ASC (Association of School Councils) Update

- Ummul went through the meetings minutes from the ASC AGM:
 - Transportation was a priority concern of discussion.
 - Every campus has completed their AGM and have all elected a chair and vice-chair.
