- \$2,278.50 be supplied to cover 50% of the cost of the VRCORE Education program as approved at the October meeting-outstanding. Invoice has not been received yet.
- \$20,954.71 for the purchase of 30 Chromebooks approved on 2023 Nov 3- outstanding. Sanjib will issue the funds.

Administration Update

- There will continue to be upcoming technology asks. Unspecified at this time.
- Portals are still outstanding. When approved this will add two additional classes. This
 may influence technology asks.

- Doug has spoken to all staff and asked them to identify any curriculum appropriate fieldtrips that they'd like society to fund. At present there hasn't been current asks.
 Planning is often done in August.
- Skiing was brought forward as an idea that society would like to fund. Jim shared that
 the PE department had researched the ski options and the cost-benefit ratio wasn't
 providing a value for the students-cost substantially increasing without providing
 enough time on the hill and with an instructor. The school will look into skiing again next
 year.
- Swimming is a fieldtrip that the society is prepared to fund for next year and NMS will approach society with same.
- Regarding robotics request, the board found a province wide initiative that supports
 robotic programming. NMS has put their names forward for this program. It's cost
 neutral. The private companies were offering products that were not sustainable as they
 require updates and replacements every few years, often at costs that were considered
 very high.
